

CITY OF BRIDGETON  
ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SPEED HUMPS ON MAYOR AITKEN RIVE

WHEREAS, the City of Bridgeton deems it is in the best interests of the City of Bridgeton to advance public safety and the expedition of traffic by establishing speed humps on portions of Mayor Aitken Drive as a traffic calming measure; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A.39:4-8.10 provides for a municipality to construct traffic calming measures where appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer for the City of Bridgeton has proposed the placement of five (5) speed humps with appropriate signage and pavement markings on Mayor Aitken Drive as set forth on the attached Schedule A;

WHEREAS, the Engineer for the City of Bridgeton has certified that the proposed speed humps on Mayor Aitken Drive have been based upon an engineering study considering the posted speed, the number of vehicles on Mayor Aitken Drive per day and the location of the proposed speed humps and has certified that the speed humps are consistent with accepted engineering standards, conform to guidelines issued by the Commissioner of Transportation and do not impact on roadways in adjoining municipalities or county or on State roadways and has certified further that the speed humps and signage and pavement markings conform to the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Bridgeton as follows:

1. The proposed placement of five (5) speed humps on Mayor Aitken Drive, together with the placement of signs and pavement markings, is approved as set forth in attached Schedule A.
