

ORDINANCE NO. 16-13
CITY OF BRIDGETON ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 149 ARTICLE II OF
THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BRIDGETON

WHEREAS, Ordinances 08-11, 11-25, and 12-15 were adopted establishing fees for medical services provided by the Department of Fire, and;

WHEREAS, the Administration of the City of Bridgeton reviews fees from time to time and has recommended a change in Chapter 149, Article II, 149-27 H. and I. amending and adding various fees be enacted by the City Council of the City of Bridgeton, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bridgeton concurs with the proposed fee amendments and additions.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by City Council of the City of Bridgeton that the fee in Chapter 149, Article II, 149-27 H. is changed as follows:

1. Amend H (5) to read: There shall be a fee of \$45 for Cervical Collar.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by City Council of the City of Bridgeton that Chapter 149, Article II, 149-27 I. is amended as follows:

1. Add I (1) to read: There shall be a fee of \$75 for on-site evaluation.
2. Change I (1) to I (2) and amend to read: Light Rescue: batteries, fluid, stabilization. There shall be a fee of \$325 for light rescue operations such as stabilization, use of hand tools, hazard control, extrication of patient from vehicle, and other scene related light rescue operations.
3. Change I (2) to I (3) and amend fee to \$700.
4. Change I (3) to I (4) and amend fee to \$1500.
