

**ORDINANCE NO. 17-2  
CITY OF BRIDGETON**

**AMENDING CHAPTER 300 OF THE GENERAL CODE OF THE CITY OF  
BRIDGETON REGARDING MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE COLLECTION**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bridgeton has enacted ordinance provisions concerning municipal solid waste and recyclable materials collection; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bridgeton is desirous of updating such ordinance to clarify certain requirements and to clarify that more than two solid waste receptacles are allowed to be placed curbside as long as they are purchased and serialized as outlined in Article VI of Chapter 300-37. Definitions; and

**WHEREAS**, each set of the two allowable receptacles must have separate accounts; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Bridgeton that Chapter 300, Article VI of the Code of the City of Bridgeton is hereby amended and Section 300-37, Authorized Containers/Receptacles definition, shall cease to read as heretofore, and shall hereafter read as follows:

**§ 300-37 DEFINITIONS**

**AUTHORIZED CONTAINERS/RECEPTACLES**

Only two (2) solid waste containers per account are authorized to be placed curbside for waste collection:

- One ninety-six (or thirty-five-) gallon, serialized, rolling trash container (hereinafter referred to as a “rolling trash container”); and
- One ninety-six (or thirty-five-) gallon, serialized, rolling single-stream recyclable (SSR) container (hereinafter referred to as a “SSR container”).

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Bridgeton that in all other respects Chapter 300 of the Code of the City of Bridgeton shall remain unaffected and unaltered by the provisions hereof.
