

ORDINANCE NO. 22-17
ORDINANCE STATEMENT AND SUMMARY

The ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the City of Bridgeton, in the County of Cumberland, State of New Jersey on June 21, 2022 and the 20 day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full ordinance are available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Municipal Clerk's office for members of the general public who request the same. The summary of the terms of such ordinance follows:

Title: "ORDINANCE RE-APPROPRIATING \$50,000 PROCEEDS OF OBLIGATIONS NOT NEEDED FOR RENOVATIONS TO THE CITY HALL ANNEX BUILDING IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE PHONE SYSTEM IN CITY HALL AND OTHER LOCATIONS IN AND BY THE CITY OF BRIDGETON, IN THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND, NEW JERSEY"

Purpose: \$50,000 is re-appropriated from Ordinance #18-10 of the City of Bridgeton, in the County of Cumberland, New Jersey (the "City"), finally adopted May 15, 2018, as supplemented by Bond Ordinance #19-17, finally adopted October 1, 2019, which were no longer necessary to provide for renovations to the City Hall Annex Building (the "Re-Appropriation Amount"). The Re-Appropriation Amount is no longer necessary to provide for these renovations and will now be used for the replacement of the phone system in City Hall and other locations, including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.
