

Bridgeton Municipal Port Authority

In 1983, consistent with N.J.S.A 40:68A-4, Bridgeton City Council created the Bridgeton Municipal Port Authority to take advantage of revitalization opportunities along the Cohansey River. With that in mind, the Municipal Port Authority acquired land in the Grove Street-South Avenue corridor in 1985 that ultimately became the Port Authority site. The site remains part of a broader redevelopment plan created in 1987 to facilitate growth and revitalization.
