The City of Bridgeton Fire Department is accepting applications for the positions of per-diem Emergency Medical Technician (EMT).

Bridgeton Fire Department EMTs provide 911 BLS transport in a 77+ square mile area, operating in a progressive system, providing care under defined protocols from our Medical Director, utilizing a modern fleet of 7 BLS units and related equipment. Department-sponsored training and CORE classes are available for all employees.

Full-time EMT compensation Starts at \$21.00/hour. Full-time EMT schedule consists of a rotating 36 hour and 48-hour week which includes built-in overtime, for compensation of approximately \$43,600.00/annually. Full-time EMTs will be enrolled in the NJ State Pension system (PERS) and are eligible for all other benefits offered to NJ State Civil Service employees.

Per-diem EMT compensation starts at \$24.00/hour. Per-diem EMT's may work up to 24 hours per week on average. The City of Bridgeton Fire Department prefers to hire from within, giving Per-diem EMT's opportunity for full time employment with benefits.

- Must be a US Citizen, NJ resident and valid NJ driver's license
- Must be at least 18 years of age and possess a high school diploma or GED
- Must be of good moral character & not convicted of a criminal offense
- Current NJ EMT or NJ MICP Certification
- Current American Heart Association BLS Provider CPR
- Completion of ICS-100, ICS-200, IS-700 preferred
- <u>Preferred</u>: History of providing 911 EMS service and experience operating an emergency vehicle
- All encouraged to apply regardless of experience
