

## CITY COUNCIL MEETING

A Special Meeting of the Bridgeton City Council was held on Tuesday, March 31, 2015 at 6:30 p.m., City of Bridgeton Police and Municipal Court Complex, 330 Fayette Street, Bridgeton, New Jersey in Council Chambers.

The meeting was called to order by Council President Jack Surrency.

The Statement of Meeting Notice was read by Municipal Clerk, Darlene J. Richmond, "Adequate notice of this meeting pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 giving the time, date, location and agenda to the extent known has been given in the following manner:

Mayor Kelly introduced the presenters Ms. Cindy Williams of Cindy Williams Design, LLC, consultant regarding branding the Park and Michael Divietro and Teresa Divietro of Land Dimensions consultant giving recommendations regarding enhancement of the Park.

At the conclusion of presentations, Pres. Surrency announced this being the time and place set forth for the public to address Council with their comments on the consent agenda items or any other matter.

It was moved by Ms. Lugardo-Hemple and seconded by Mr. Edwards that the meeting be opened to the public for anyone desiring to be heard, which motion was carried.

Location of Vo-Tech Houses-one behind hall of Fame and one by old ambulance building on Scholastic Drive  
Synthetic Ice attraction  
Inflatable Movie Screens  
Signage for Rhododendron Garden-move forward with getting partners to assist with gardens.  
Weddings and Quinceaneras in the Park  
Nail House Improvements  
Food Truck  
Zip Line-work with developer to provide at no cost to the City of Bridgeton Improve Amphitheater in existing condition for hosting concerts-event planner and promoters to set up concerts  
Kiosk by Zoo entrance  
Park signage as required

No one else desiring to be heard, it was moved by Ms. Lugardo-Hemple and seconded by Mr. Edwards that the public portion be closed, which motion was carried.

RESOLUTION NO. 107-15 appoints Engineering Design Associates P.A. as conflicts engineer for City, Planning and Zoning Board of Adjustments.

It was moved by Mr. Edwards and seconded by Ms. Lugardo-Hemple that the Resolutions listed under the consent agenda be adopted, which motion was carried by unanimous roll call vote. The original resolutions may be found in the Resolution Book.

Pres. Surrency called upon the Mayor for comments.

Mayor Kelly requested that the items listed by Business Administrator be acted upon by Council to approve going forward with these projects.

It was moved by Ms. Lugardo-Hemple and second by Mr. Edwards to approve going forward with the list of projects for the Park presented by the Business Administrator, which motion was carried by unanimous roll call vote with Mr. Zapolski and Mr. Spence being absent.

Pres. Surrency called upon Council for remarks.
