

CITY OF BRIDGETON

ORDINANCE DESIGNATING CRANE STREET AS A ONE-WAY STREET

WHEREAS, the County of Cumberland is contemplating a move of certain county offices into a building at 164 W. Broad Street in the City of Bridgeton and said building has a parking lot with access to Crane Street, a city-owned street;

WHEREAS, the County of Cumberland has asked the City of Bridgeton to designate Crane Street a one-way street from Broad Street to Academy Street, to provide for travel in a southerly direction and to prohibit parking on both sides of the street in order to facilitate the flow of traffic;

WHEREAS, the Engineer for the City of Bridgeton has reviewed the request of the County of Cumberland regarding regulations for Crane Street and states there is no impact upon any State Highways and there is no objection to the adoption of the requested regulations;


WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bridgeton has no objection to making said street a one-way street, to allowing the flow of traffic in a southerly direction only and to prohibiting parking on said street;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Bridgeton that the flow of traffic and parking be regulated on Crane Street only as set forth below:


<u>Street</u>	<u>Direction of Travel</u>	<u>Limits</u>	<u>Side Parking Permitted</u>
Crane	South	Between Broad Street (Rt.49) and Academy Street	None

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Bridgeton that appropriate signs and markings be placed or installed as may be required by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, said signs and markings on Crane Street by the County of Cumberland.
