Administrator reported on Main Street funding and they have turned in their proposed budget and holding interviews for Executive Director. The recommendation for funding for this year is \$60,000 and next year \$40,000 a two year agreement Resolution will be prepared for next meeting.
Councilman Edwards pointed out stipulation for Main Street that they will be held accountable for their expenditures.
Councilman Zapolski inquired about funding of the Library and suggested that the Solicitor prepare a non binding referendum question to the residents whether we should fully fund the Library and letting them know that there would be an impact on the tax rate and that is what he is asking. Discussion concerning the matter was entered into at the conclusion no decision.
