## CITY OF BRIDGETON NOTICE OF PENDING ORDINANCE

## ORDINANCE DECLARING AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE OR DIRT BIKE OPERATED ON A PUBLIC STREET, HIGHWAY OR RIGHT OF WAY IN VIOLATION OF N.J.S.A. 39:3C-17 AN IMMEDIATE THREAT TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY OR WELFARE AND DESIGNATING SUCH VEHICLES AS CONTRABAND SUBJECT TO FORFEITURE

This Ordinance declares all-terrain vehicles and/or dirt bikes being driven on a public street, highway or right of way as a threat to the public health, safety and welfare. This Ordinance also explains that said vehicles will be considered as contraband subject to forfeiture and possible destruction.

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the City Council of the City of Bridgeton, in the County of Cumberland, State of New Jersey, on May 17, 2022. It will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing at a meeting of said City Council to be held in Council Chambers at the Police and Municipal Court Complex, 330 Fayette Street, Bridgeton, New Jersey on June 7, 2022 at 5:30 pm.
